

State COVID-Operation Snapshot for Georgia

On August 15, Governor Kemp issued an executive order extending COVID-19 restrictions and permitting limited local mask mandates. The order extends the shelter in place order for the medically fragile, continues the ban on large gatherings, and maintains health and safety protocols for Georgia businesses.

Local governments will be permitted to required individuals to wear face masks on public property, but a threshold of more than 100 confirmed cases per 100,000 people over the previous 14 days must be reached for municipalities to impose a mask mandate. Nonprofits and private businesses are exempt from mask mandates.
