Dear Chairman Neal, Chairman Grassley, Ranking Member Brady and Ranking Member Wyden:

On behalf of manufacturers and other businesses in the United States and the millions of workers our organizations represent, we are writing to urge a legislative fix to language in the United States—Mexico—Canada Agreement Implementation Act that—if uncorrected—will result in the payment of millions of dollars of fees on imports into the United States.

Section 205 of the USMCA Implementation Act, as drafted, allows companies to claim refunds of the merchandise processing fee at the time of entry, but precludes companies from making a post-importation claim for such refunds. Merchandise processing fee refunds are eligible for post-importation claims under other U.S. free trade agreements.

Our organizations are committed to the successful implementation of the USMCA, which will help manufacturers and other businesses grow in the United States, compete globally and support millions of well-paying jobs across the country as we lead our economic recovery and renewal. A timely fix to the merchandise processing fee drafting error in the USMCA Implementation Act is critical to enabling this success given the substantial number of post-importation preference claims that we expect will be filed in the coming months.

We appreciate your support for fixing the merchandise processing fee drafting error and look forward to working with you and your teams to remedy this issue as expeditiously as possible.
