
PETITION FOR REVIEW

Pursuant to Rule 15 of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and section 307(b) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b), the SIP/FIP Advocacy Group hereby petitions the Court for review of the final action of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency entitled “Action To Ensure Authority To Issue Permits Under the Prevention of Significant Deterioration Program to Sources of Greenhouse Gas Emissions: Finding of Substantial Inadequacy and SIP Call,” 75 Fed. Reg. 77,698 (Dec. 13, 2010), to be codified at 40 CFR Part 52. The SIP/FIP Advocacy Group files this petition in this Court because Respondent has asserted this rulemaking is of nationwide scope and effective, but Petitioner advises the Court that a petition has already been filed in the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit.

The SIP/FIP Advocacy Group has also filed a petition for review in the Fifth Circuit, pending a ruling on motions filed there to dismiss or transfer to this Court.

A copy of the final rule is attached to this petition.


RULE 26.1 CORPORATE DISCLOSURE STATEMENT


