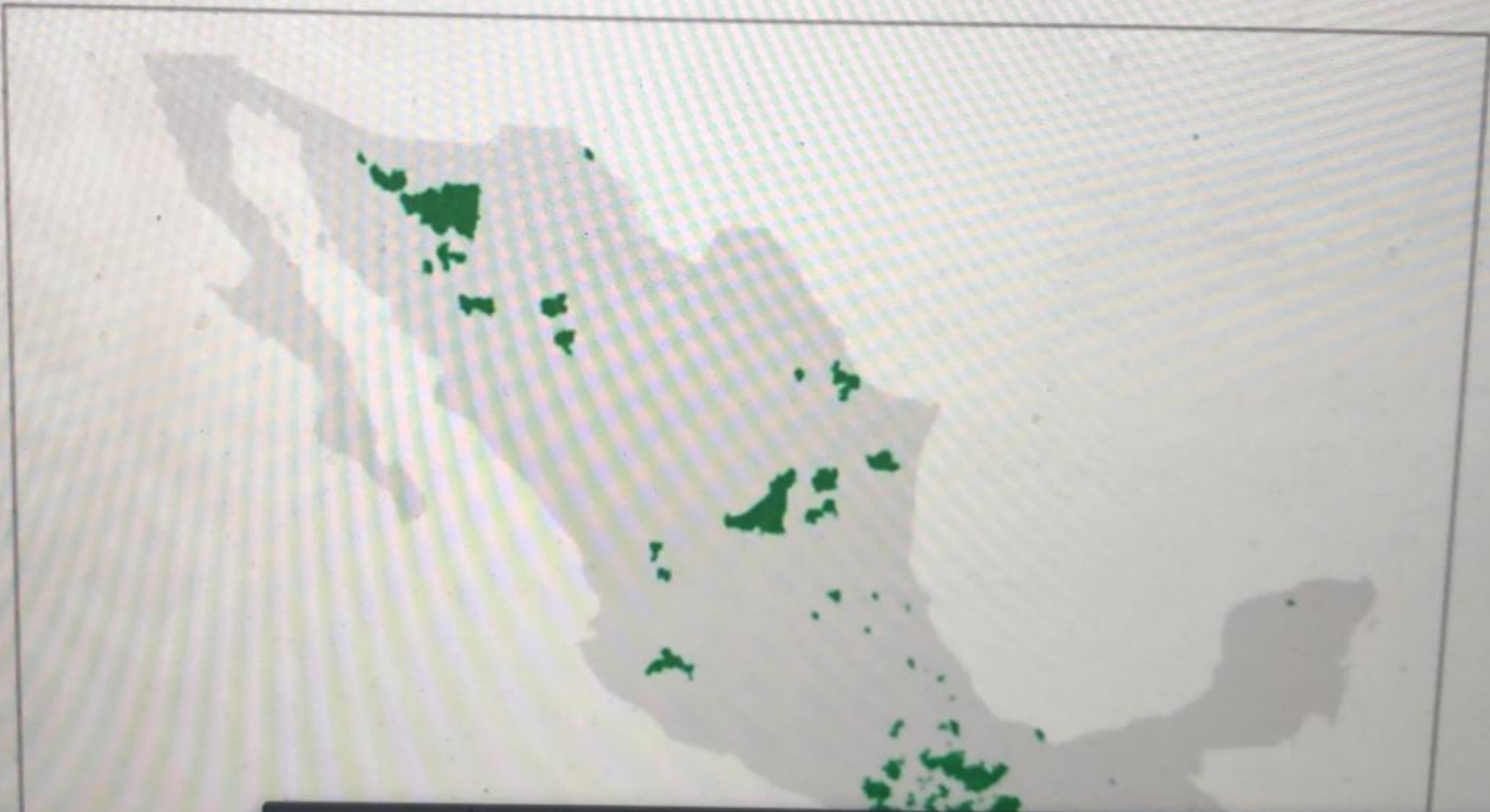


Three phases

Phase 1: Towns of Hope Reopen











Phase 2: Preparation for Reopening

- Phase 2 will begin on **May 18** and finish on **May 31**.
- During these two weeks, all actors will **prepare** for reopening.
- The four main duties are:
 - i. The development of **health protocols** by the companies.
 - ii. Training employees in safety procedures.
 - iii. Reconfiguring spaces and **production processes** to ensure social distancing.
 - iv. Entrance **controls**, cleaning and disinfecting procedures.

Phase 3: Traffic light system

- Phase 3 will begin on **June 1** and consists of a **traffic light** system.
- Some regions will be in **red** light, others in **orange**, some others in **yellow** and a few more in **green**.
- **Construction, mining and transportation** will be considered as essential activities and will be able to return to their activities since June 1.
