SUBJECT: Bridge of the Americas (BOTA) resumes commercial operations, effective Tuesday, October 10, 2023

DISTRIBUTION: Customs Brokers, Importers and Other Interested Parties

PURPOSE: This Trade Information Notice is to inform the trade community that commercial operations resumes at the Bridge of the Americas (BOTA) Cargo Lot, effective Tuesday, October 10, 2023. However, due to the migrant surge, the processing capacity will be reduced as U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) continues to provide support to the United States Border Patrol (USBP).

CBP will remain transparent and will reassess this dynamic situation as necessary. Stakeholders will be provided updates to changes or suspension of operations as they become available. In addition, the El Paso Field Office (EPFO) reminds trade stakeholders of other available commercial cargo facilities as listed below.
