Dear Speaker Pelosi, Leader McCarthy, Chairman Nadler and Ranking Member Collins:

America's immigration system is broken, and manufacturers are calling on Congress and the administration to overhaul the current system for a safer country and a stronger, smarter economy. While we continue to support comprehensive immigration reform as a long-term solution, we urge your support for bipartisan legislation that promotes American values and recognizes that immigrants are an integral part of our communities, families and workplaces.

Dreamers, including participants in the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrival program, and participants in the Temporary Protected Status program continue to face uncertainty under our broken immigration system. These individuals should not have to live in fear of deportation. Congress needs to send a strong signal that we welcome their talents, contributions of hard work, desire for education, and if serving, support their willingness to wear the uniform of the armed forces.

Manufacturers call on Congress to assure Dreamers and TPS recipients that their future is safe. Manufacturers will stand by efforts that improve our immigration system, enhance border security and provide long-term certainty for these two populations, including a path to citizenship for Dreamers and a path to permanent legal status for TPS recipients in the country.
